

Honorary Publications Officer

The Society is seeking new Honorary Publications Officer following the decision of the incumbent to step down in April 2012. This is an unremunerated position but travel and subsistence expenses are paid. The successful candidate will be required to attend four Council meetings a year and to become actively involved in the work of the Society in general.
